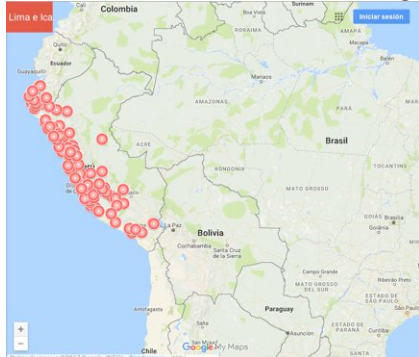

The land purchase deal fell through. With cash in hand, we continue to look and pray.

The 398 handmade quilts for PUNO will be in Lima customs storage by the time you read and respond to this letter. The next step is clearing customs, which looks like it will cost more than I thought including storage, dock, and unloading charges. Keep praying we can get them to Puno without a lot of charges & delays.



As I am sure you already know it has been a rough past month for most of the coast of Peru because of the unusual rains

and flooding. (red dots indicating land-slides).

Many have prayed and some have given towards the need. All designated gifts will be used towards flood relief. The BBFI Bible College here lost some buildings but no one was hurt. It will be an expensive long-term rebuilding process.



PERUVIAN LOAN FUND

Monthly repayments to the interest-free revolving fund averaged \$6000 in 2016. We have 23 active loans with 12 more who have fallen behind in repayments. Just two loans, totaling \$5,000.00, have been written off as losses. Fifty-two churches have totally repaid loans, and 14 of those churches took out a second or third loan (which have been repaid as well). ¡To GOD be the Glory!
