Our Update

Dear Prayer Team,

Just a few days before we were to return to Peru (with bags packed), we got a surprise Doctors heart report and recommendation. They found that my LAD was 85% blocked. So once again plans changed, They placed a stent in the heart artery, going through my right wrist and



across my arm, chest, and heart. I left the clinic after an one hour observation time. The next few days I felt great, not realizing how not so great I had been feeling for months.

Meanwhile Debbie had a cyst surgically removed from an arthritic joint on her right hand ,middle finger. Just yesterday they removed the stitches and the long incision is healing up fine. So now we both have more Dr. Appointments in November. Which means we are still in Amarillo TX.

Now we have planned to get the health issues straightened out and return to the field in January of 2026. The same heart doctor said he can fix the pain in my legs and feet that keeps me from sleeping much of the time. He said some of the tests revealed that the veins and arteries in my legs are shot but there is a solution.
